



The Badger Town Council would like to advised residents of the following grants it has received.

Town improvements

- -a one thousand dollar (\$1,000) grant from MMSB for Come Home Year Community Clean-up Project.
- -a seven thousand five hundred dollar (\$7,500) grant from Active NL for upgrades to the Loggers' Way Walking Trail.
- -a two thousand five hundred dollar (\$2,500) Come Home Year Grant to construct new picnic tables to be placed along the Loggers' Way Walking Trail.
- -a ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) Community Allotment grant from Marathon Gold.
- -Sunset Drive Water/Sewer Project to replace a section of water/sewer main lines. Liftstation Rehabilitation Project- 3 Stations- Badger Drive, Main Street, and Maple Street.

Student Summer Employment:

- -Service Canada two (2) student employees for 8 weeks at 35 hours per week.
- -Qalipu First Nation one (1) student employee for 7 weeks at 35 hours per week.
