### **Discussion:**

- 1. Fire Chief Gus Loder was unable to attend tonight's meeting.
- 2. Discussion with Town Superintendent Scott Luscombe.
- Scott informed Council that the pump house is working good. He stated that there is a smell from the lines and therefore will begin to flush lines on Monday's and Friday's. Notification will be posted for residents to inform them of the waterline flushing. Deputy Mayor Butt inquired as to whether flushing the water lines for longer periods would be more beneficial. Scott stated that the waterlines when flushed the first or second time would become clearer.
- Pavement cuts are all ready. Six tons should be sufficient to fill what needs to be completed. The pavement roller from Exploits Paving will be made available to the Town once they have finished using it. Scott informed Council that the pavement should be at least 3 ½ inches thick when placed and be two (2) inches when rolled in.
